1 Thessalonians 1:8 "The Lord's message rang out from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia – your faith in God has become known everywhere."

Thessalonica was an influential city located on the Via Ignatia (the way of the nations). As a seaport with a fertile plain, it had a diverse population of Germanic peoples, Greeks, Romans and Jews. Thessalonica was the capital city and largest city of Macedonia as well as a political center for the region. It was a free Roman city.

Enter the apostle Paul and his disciples Silas and Timothy. Paul entered the city and preached on three sabbaths in the Synagogue the message that Jesus is the Messiah and that He rose from the dead. The result was that "...some Jews were persuaded and joined Paul as well as a large number of God-fearing Greeks and not a few prominent women. (Acts 17:4)

In 1 Thessalonians 1, Paul reveals the impact the believers had was not only in their city but in the entire region. "The Lord's message rang out (or sounded out, literally echoed) not only in Macedonia and Achaia – your faith in God has become known everywhere."

What an awesome impact this early church had on its community and region. Central Baptist Association in central New Mexico is not unlike Thessalonica in its population. We are a diverse population, a cross roads in the State and Nation, a political center and we live with a freedom to express our faith and message.

As we continue to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ, that He is the Messiah, that He did die and rose from the dead, many will believe. The church in Thessalonica did not have great fan-fair, big events or over-the-top presentations to draw people to come. They had a message that they proclaimed and lived out in such a way that it

impacted the lost community in a way that echoed far beyond their local area.

My hearts desire is that each of our churches will have a reputation built on the message of Christ's love for all that will echo far beyond their own neighborhoods. I pray that the love of Christ will impower and resonate through the lives of each one of His children so powerfully that it will touch the lives of all they meet not only in their own neighborhoods but in their city, state and nation.
