

Three Words that Changed the World:

Growing up I was one of “those” kids. You know, the kids that didn’t quite fit into any real category; the kids that didn’t have athletic ability and were not the brightest bulb on the string. I didn’t have charisma or confidence. My “friends” list was very small and when it came to be chosen for any kind of activity I was almost always picked last. I was skinny and tall (six foot and 120 pounds wet) with little coordination. In ninth grade I was on the football team. Back then we played on dirt fields. There were two people on the third string and I was one of them. We were basically tackling dummies for the rest of the team. There was not a lot of encouragement from my parents for various reasons. Once I hit the teen years there was little oversight other than to stay out of trouble or else. I really had no direction or purpose in my life.

On the other hand, I had a few friends who were all the things I wasn’t. They were popular, involved, athletic and smart. They had many friends and support from family. It seemed they had everything I wanted, yet didn’t have.

We live in a world where the two scenarios are played out every day in individual lives. Along with these, there are individuals that fit between the two extremes. One truth is common for each one of us though, hopelessness. I really didn’t have hope in my life and those with seemingly everything didn’t have any real hope either. In fact, Ephesians 2:11-13 reads *“Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called “the uncircumcision” by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands— remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.”*

So, what are the three words that changed the world? The three words that have given us hope, promise, strength, love, grace and faith? Three words that were spoken eight hundred years before they became a life changing reality? The words come from Matthew 1:23 which is a reference to Isaiah 7:14 *“The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel – which means “God with us.”* Yes, that’s it... *“God with us.”* He’s not distant, He is not just a religious icon. He is the King of Kings and Lord of Lord’s. He is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. He is the Creator, sustainer and redeemer of life. He is with us who are sinners in need of a Savior. He sent His Son Jesus to pay a price for our sin we could never pay ourselves. He is the one who gives us hope, comfort, strength, guidance, grace and forgiveness. He is our “all in all.”

Christmas is the celebration of His coming to be with us, so we can be with Him. Celebrate Him, worship Him, share Him and reflect Him in your lives so that the world will see the wonderful gift our loving God has offered everyone, salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.


