Shocking, simply shocking! Tuesday, August 13th, I woke up, readied myself and headed to the CBA office. I almost always get to the office by 7:00 am or earlier. As I turned into the parking area I noticed lots of water in the parking lot in front of the entry door. Rats! I thought, the sprinkler system was leaking. So, I parked and headed toward the door. I noticed that there was a fog on the inside of the entry door and a steady stream of water flowing out from under the door.

I immediately knew this was not a good sign and that something obviously was wrong. I silently hoped it was on the side of the Baptist Foundation (sorry guys) but quickly realized it was on the CBA side. I entered and heard "rushing water" which I knew wasn't good. There was about two inches of water on the carpet, so I checked the women's bathroom but couldn't find a leak. I went to the men's bathroom and there it was... the supply line for the toilet had ruptured and water was shooting out of the line like a fire hose (little exaggeration). I couldn't turn the water off by hand, so I had to find a wrench and finally, after having quite a good shower, secured the line. Soggy is too soft a word to describe the carpet, it was more like a swamp. I immediately contacted our insurance company and a water extraction company who came out, vacuumed up the water and set up 15 blowers and 3 huge humidifiers to try to dry out the carpet and walls. Six days later they removed the equipment. It stayed over a hundred degrees in the office, I could have hung meat and made jerky in that environment.

We now begin having tile and new carpet put in the office. The Baptist Foundation has graciously allowed us to use one of their offices. We are putting tile in the main area, hall and bathrooms and a different type of carpet in the offices and conference room. It will look nice.

God has so blessed CBA through your faithful support and encouragement. We are grateful that during challenges we have a faithful Father who watches over us and gives us strength and guidance to work through everything that happens in our lives and ministries. Jesus is our source of refreshing because He is the Living Water and we certainly desire our lives to be flooded with His love and presence.

Hopefully, we will be back on our offices in a week or two.

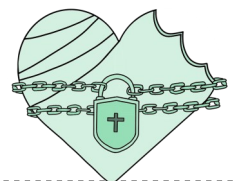
