Church Administration CLE 2412 Taught by John Torrison 3 hours Tuesdays, Class starts of January 5 – April 20 6:00 - 9:00 pm CBA*

An introduction to basic principles and methods of leadership, administration, and church growth in a church from 10-100. Unique aspects of biblical leadership as applied to the local church.

Baptist Heritage and Practice CLL 1113 Taught by David McConkey 3 hours Thursdays, Class starts January 7 – April 15 6:00 - 9:00 pm CBA*

This course is a study of Baptist origins, development, doctrines, confessions, polity, leaders, and current trends. This course emphasizes the history and state of Southern Baptist (SBC) life relative to the cultural context of the CLD center which is offering the course.

Principles & Approaches to Bible Teaching CLE 1113 Taught by Harry Gullett 3 hours Mondays, Class starts January 4, 2021 – April 26 6:00 - 9:00 pm CBA*

This course includes a study of the principles and methods of preparation, delivery, and evaluation for transformational Bible teaching. The course content includes a discussion of appropriate handling of the text and effective application of biblical principles.

Making Disciples CLE 2371 Taught by Jonathan Jimmerson 3 hours Mondays, Class starts January 4, 2021 -April 12 6:00 – 9:00 pm Vertical Church, 4801 Montano Plaza Suite A10

This course explores the process of spiritual development as well as methods of discipleship practiced in the church. Students will examine the biblical backgrounds of discipleship and the role of spiritual disciplines, community, development of spiritual gifts, and accountability in spiritual growth.
